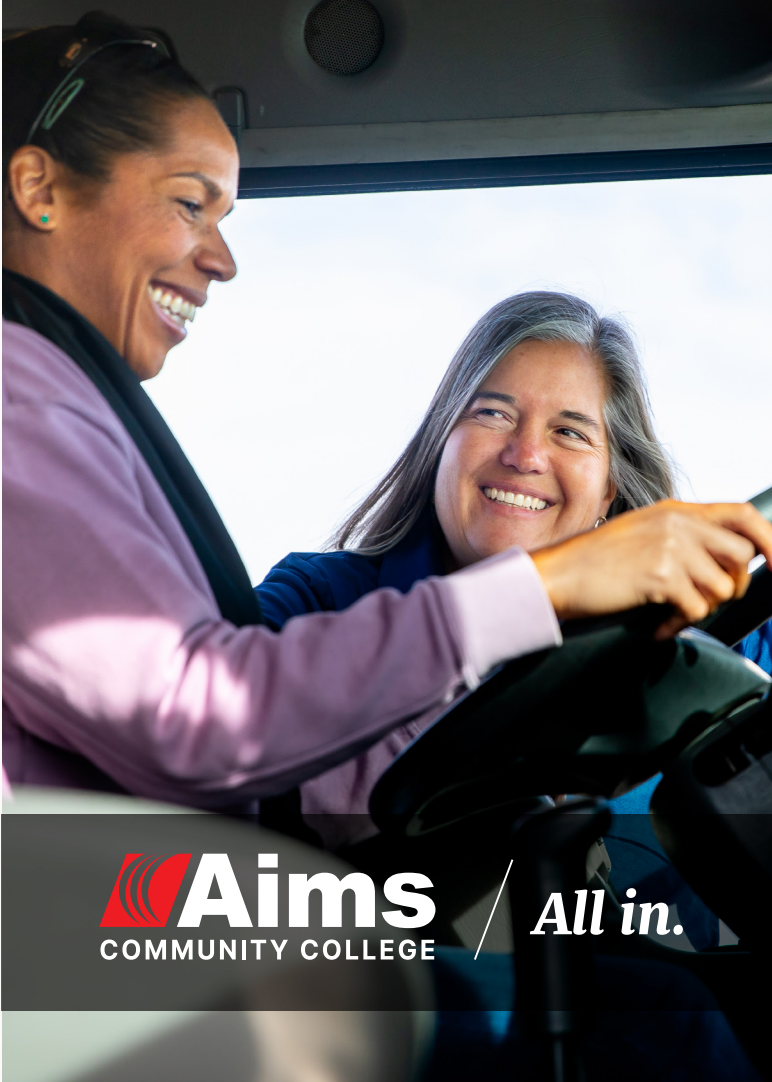

HAZMAT ENDORSEMENT

STEPS TO ENROLL

1. Possess a current, valid regular driver license.
2. Complete and pass a Department of Transportation (DOT) physical exam and obtain a DOT medical card.
3. Complete and pass a drug screen and background check and pay the \$120 registration fee.
4. Obtain a Commercial Learner Permit (CLP).

PAYMENT/FUNDING OPTIONS

- We accept cash, checks and credit cards.
- Funding may be available from community organizations such as your county workforce development center, your employer or Aims scholarships.

Please note: CDL is a non-credit program, and Aims federal and state financial aid are not available for CDL classes.

CLASS A

Types of vehicles requiring a Class A license:

- Tractor-trailers
- Truck and trailer combinations

Class Options:

- Training sessions are three or four weeks (120 or 150 hours), depending on whether you have a Commercial Learner Permit.
- The training program includes the Class A test with an Aims state-certified, third-party examiner.

Pricing

- Class A \$3,500, plus registration fee
- CDL testing is included with your tuition

CLASS B

Types of vehicles requiring a Class B license:

- Straight trucks
- Large passenger buses (15 or more)
- Box trucks
- Dump trucks

Class Options:

- Training sessions are divided into online training sessions with weekend behind-the-wheel training sessions.

Pricing

- Class B \$1,800, plus registration fee
- CDL testing is included with your tuition
