Posthumous Credentials

Upon request, Aims Community College may recognize a student's work by conferring a degree or certificate posthumously to the next of kin of a deceased student.

To be eligible the following criteria must be met:

- The deceased student was enrolled at Aims Community College within one year of their death.
- The deceased student is in good academic standing and has earned a minimum grade point average of 2.0
- The deceased student has completed a minimum of two-thirds of course and credit hour requirements for their program of study.

If all criteria are met, the request must be approved by the CEO/President. The credential will bear the notation "Awarded Posthumously." Exceptions may be granted with the approval of the CEO/President.
