CORE MEASURE DATA DEFINITIONS

QUICK STATS

Student Headcount

Registered, withdrawn, or audit students during an academic year. It includes concurrent students but excludes Continuing Education students.

Degrees & Certificates Awarded

Count of all degrees and certificates earned by students during an academic year.

Gender

Whether students are female or male. Students whose gender was unreported or non-binary was adjusted to either gender by ID number (odd male, even female).

Race/Ethnicity

White + Unknown include white, non-resident alien (includes anyone who is not a U.S. citizen), unknown. Students of color includes Hispanic ethnicity and other races.

Benchmarks

Three-year average annual unduplicated headcount

Average unduplicated headcount of students who were registered for, withdrew from, or audited courses during past three academic years. It includes concurrent students but excludes Continuing Education students.

Three-year average one year retention including graduation

Average (for the most recent three years available) retention rate of first time college level degree-seeking students, with retention defined as those who start in a term within the academic year and enroll in the same term in the subsequent academic year or graduate prior to that.

Three-year average rate of graduation within 150% of normal time to completion (three years)

Average (for the most recent 3 years available) of the 150% graduation rates (meaning graduation within three years of their starting term) of first time college level degree-seeking students who start in a term within the academic year.

Current Performance

Annual unduplicated headcount

Unduplicated headcount of students who were registered for, withdrew from, or audited courses in an academic year. It includes concurrent students but excludes Continuing Education students.

One year retention including graduation

Retention rate of first time college level degree-seeking students, with retention defined as those who start in a term within the academic year and enroll in the same term in the subsequent academic year or graduate prior to that.

Rate of graduation within 150% of normal time to completion (three years)

150% graduation rate (meaning graduation within three years of their starting term) of first time college level degree-seeking students who start in a term within the academic year.
